COURSES OFFERED BY SUBJECT

ENGLISH / LANGUAGE ARTS

These courses stress vocabulary, reading comprehension, and a writing process focusing on skills from pre-writing to publishing. Spelling, grammar, usage, capitalization, punctuation, and composition skills are taught at the grade-appropriate level. Handwriting, keyboarding, test-taking and study skills are integrated into each course.

ELA 091 – KINDERGARTEN ENGLISH/LANG ARTS - 1ST SEM 0.5 CREDIT

Prepares children for a lifetime of successful reading through practice in listening and speaking skills, fine motor skills, and visual and auditory discrimination. Letter recognition and writing the letters A – Z are introduced along with phonemic awareness, and sound to symbol correspondence.

This course introduces fun, decodable books that provide independent reading practice and reinforce high-frequency words and phonics skills.

Introduces writing letter, numbers and shapes.

ELA 092 – KINDERGARTEN ENGLISH/LANG ARTS - 2ND SEM 0.5 CREDIT

Students learn to hear, focus on, and recognize the basic phonemes and graphemes found in our spoken and written language. Skills from PHON 091 are reinforced and initial consonant and short vowel sounds are introduced.

This course introduces fun, decodable books that provide independent reading practice and reinforce high-frequency words and phonics skills.

Reinforces letter writing, numbers, and shapes.

ELA 101 – 1ST GRADE ENGLISH/LANG ARTS - 1ST SEM

0.5 CREDIT

Every common sound to symbol relationship is thoroughly taught and mastered. Beginning consonant sounds and short vowels sounds are reviewed. Medial and ending consonant sounds are introduced. Comprehension, vocabulary and beginning writing skills are reinforced.

Authentic literature is enhanced by systematically developing reading, writing, phonics, and fluency skills. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Introduces standard printing.

ELA 102 – 1ST GRADE ENGLISH/LANG ARTS - 2ND SEM

0.5 CREDIT

Students focus on word segmentation, blending, and word building, empowering them to use phonics as a strategic tool for reading, writing, and spelling. Skills from PHON 101 are reinforced. Long vowels, consonant blends, using Y as a vowel, endings, digraphs, and contractions are introduced.

This course reviews and extends skills taught in ELA 101, including reading literature and systematically developing reading, writing, phonics, and fluency skills. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary, spelling and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Introduces standard printing.

Students are exposed to different testing formats that include true/false, multiple choice, matching and problem solving. Students learn study strategies to better retain information by implementing time management skills, scheduling, prioritizing, and note-taking skills.

ELA 201 – 2ND GRADE ENGLISH/LANG ARTS - 1ST SEM

0.5 CREDIT

Phonics and reading are integrated so students apply newly learned decoding strategies as they read words, sentences, decodable text, and meaningful stories. High-frequency word activities develop automatic word recognition of the words students encounter most often in their reading. Initial, medial, and final consonants, short and long vowel sounds, and using Y as a vowel are reinforced. Compounds, LE words, hard and soft C and G, blends, digraphs and R-controlled vowels are introduced.

Authentic literature is enhanced by systematically developing reading, writing, phonics, and fluency skills. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Reinforces standard printing.

Students are exposed to different testing formats that include true/false, multiple choice, matching and problem solving. Students learn study strategies to better retain information by implementing time management skills, scheduling, prioritizing, and note-taking skills.

ELA 202 – 2ND GRADE ENGLISH/LANG ARTS - 2ND SEM

0.5 CREDIT

Continues instruction in high-frequency words to provide students with the tools they need to be successful readers. Skills from PHON 201 are reinforced. Contractions, endings, suffixes, vowel pairs, vowel digraphs, diphthongs, prefixes, synonyms, antonyms and homonyms are introduced.

This course reviews and extends skills taught in ELA 201, including reading literature and systematically developing reading, writing, phonics, and fluency skills. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary, spelling and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Reinforces standard printing.

ELA 301 – 3RD GRADE ENGLISH/LANG ARTS - 1ST SEM

0.5 CREDIT

Connects phonics with vocabulary, critical thinking, spelling, word building, and writing. Consonants, short and long vowels, hard and soft C and G, compounds, blends and digraphs, Y as a vowel, and R-controlled vowels are reinforced. Y as a consonant, contractions, plurals, and suffixes are introduced.

This course focuses on reading comprehension and vocabulary with an emphasis in sight words and phonics. Students read high interest stories and write sentences and short paragraphs. Each unit integrates life skill lessons on issues such as handling social relationships and reading park rules. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Introduces cursive writing.

Students are exposed to different testing formats that include true/false, multiple choice, matching and problem solving. Students learn study strategies to better retain information by implementing time management skills, scheduling, prioritizing, and note-taking skills.

0.5 CREDIT

Provides comprehension, vocabulary, and writing extensions, real reading and writing applications, standardized test practice, spelling and dictionary skills, and advanced critical-thinking skills. Reviews skills from PHON 301. Introduces vowel pairs, digraphs, diphthongs, prefixes, base words, suffixes, syllables, synonyms, antonyms, and homonyms.

This course reviews and extends skills taught in RDG 301, including reading comprehension and vocabulary with an emphasis in sight words and phonics. Students read high interest stories and write sentences and short paragraphs. Each unit integrates life skill lessons. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible

lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Introduces cursive writing.

ELA 401 – 4TH GRADE ENGLISH/LANG ARTS - 1ST SEM

0.5 CREDIT

Reviews short and long vowels, hard and soft C and G, blends, consonant digraphs, and R-controlled vowels. Introduces sounds of k, f, s, silent letters, suffixes and syllables. Encourages fluency and builds comprehension while providing skills practice with engaging phonics and reading passages.

This course focuses on advanced reading comprehension skills and vocabulary with a review in sight words and decoding skills. Students read high interest stories and apply newly acquired language skills when writing sentences and short paragraphs. Each unit integrates life skill lessons on issues such as cultural awareness and reading a schedule. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Reinforces cursive writing.

Continues instruction in vowel pairs, digraphs, diphthongs, plurals, possessives, contractions, affixes, synonyms, antonyms, homonyms, and spelling and dictionary skills.

This course reviews and extends skills taught in ELA 401, including advanced reading comprehension skills and vocabulary with a review in sight words and decoding skills. Students read high interest stories and apply newly acquired language skills when writing sentences and short paragraphs. Each unit integrates life skill lessons on issues such as cultural awareness and reading a schedule. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Reinforces cursive writing.

This course focuses on reading comprehension and vocabulary with a review in sight words and phonics. Students read high interest stories and write short paragraphs and stories. Each unit integrates life skill lessons on issues such as telephone safety and filling out a form. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Reinforces cursive writing.

Students read high interest stories and write short paragraphs and stories. Each unit integrates life skill lessons. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible

lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Reinforces cursive writing.

This course focuses on reading comprehension and vocabulary with a review in sight words and phonics. Students read high interest stories and write paragraphs and reports. Each unit integrates life skill lessons on issues such as being a good listener and filling out a credit application. Powerful strategies for mastering vocabulary and proofreading are introduced.

Students learn spelling skills based on phonics through unique, cross-curricular reading passages, practice, and high-interest writing activities. Packed with flexible lessons, these motivating activities include fun riddles and puzzles. Reinforces cursive writing.
